STORY OF KING SHAHRYAR AND HIS BROTHER

IN THE NAME OF ALLAH, THE COMPASSIONATING, THE COMPASSIONATE!
Praise be to Allah—the beneficent king—the creator of the universe—lord of the three worlds—who set up the firmament without pillars in its stead—and who stretched out the earth e'en as a bed—and grace, and prayer-blessing be upon our lord Mohammed—lord of apostolic men—and upon his family and companion train—prayer and blessings enduring and grace which unto the day of doom shall remain—amen!—O thou of the three worlds sô'reign!

AND AFTERWARD. Verily the works and words of those gone before us ha'e become instances and examples to men of our modern day, that folk may view what admonishing chances befell other folk and may therefrom take warning; and that they may peruse the annals of antique peoples and all that hath betided them, and be thereby ruled and restrained. Praise, therefore, be to Him who hath made the histories of the past an admonition unto the present! Now of such instances are the tales called "A Thousand Nights and a Night," together with their famed legends and wonders.

Therein it is related (but Allah it is All-knowing of His hidden things and All-ruling and All-honored and All-giving and All-gracious and All-merciful!) that in tide of yore and in time long gone before, there was a King of the Kings of the Banu Sasan in the islands of India and China, a Lord of armies and guards and ser'ants and dependents. He left only two sons, one in the prime of manhood and the other yet a youth, while both were knights and bra'es, albeit the elder was a doughtier horseman than the younger. So he succeeded to the empire, when he ruled the land and lorded it is o'er his lieges with justice so exemplary that he was belo'ed by all the peoples of his capital and of his kingdom.
