Cooper Black is an ultra-bold serif typeface intended for display use that was designed by Oswald Bruce Cooper and released by the Barnhart Brothers & Spindler type foundry in 1922.[1] The typeface was drawn as an extra-bold weight of Cooper's "Cooper Old Style" family. It rapidly became a standard typeface and was licensed by American Type Founders and also copied by many other manufacturers of printing systems.[2][3][4]

Cooper Black followed on from Cooper's career as a lettering artist in Chicago and the Midwest of America in the 1920s.[3][5][6] Cooper Black was advertised as being "for far-sighted printers with

În prezent, termenul de „font” este frecvent folosit ca sinonim cu termenul de set de caractere, deși inițial au avut sensuri diferite înainte de apariția tipografiei digitale și tehnoredactării. Fonturile de caractere se disting prin stilul de scriere, care include toate corpurile și grosimile caracterelor.

În fostele tipografii manuale tradiționale, cuvântul “font” s-ar referi la un set complet de forme de metal, folosit pentru a culege o pagină întreagă. In typography, a typeface (also known as font family) is a set of one or more fonts each composed of glyphs that share common design features. Each font of a typeface has a specific weight, style, condensation, width, slant, italicization, ornamentation, and designer or foundry (and formerly size, in metal fonts). For example, *ITC Garamond Bold Condensed Italic* means the bold, condensed-width, italic version of *ITC Garamond*. It is a different font from *ITC Garamond Condensed Italic* and *ITC Garamond Bold Condensed*, but all are fonts within the same typeface, *ITC Gar-*

mond. *ITC Garamond* is a different typeface from *Adobe Garamond* or *Monotype Garamond*. (These are all alternative updates or digitisations of the typeface *Garamond*, originally created in the 16th century.) There are thousands of different typefaces in existence, with new ones being developed constantly.

The art and craft of designing typefaces is called *type design*. Designers of typefaces are called *type designers* and are often employed by *type foundries*. In digital typography, type designers are sometimes also called *font developers* or *font designers*.
